The author has taken 9 broad parameters to construct the index. It is concluded that majority of sampled agriculture labours have low or medium security in terms of asset holding, food and nutrition, education, habitat, social security in terms of participation, clothing, health and information. Availability and use of modes of transport is the only indices with medium and high security. The paper suggests that employment opportunities through increased irrigation facilities and strengthening of employment generation programmes will be helpful in improving the situation.</p> <p>No. Repetition in title is not needed. 'STATE OF LIVELIHOOD SECURITY OF AGRICULTURAL LABOURERS IN ANDHRA PRADESH' Yes Yes</p> <p>The methodology needs to be elaborated with reference to a) what are the different components taken in different indices? b) how the range of low, medium and high for different indices was determined? c) why this is ex post facto research?</p> <p>Reference for the data used in initial paragraphs must be mentioned.</p> <p>The decadal data in the initial paragraphs can be concised.</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	Should be improved.	
<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>'Mandals' (development block,) may be a general term in Andhra Pradesh but not in other parts of India. While using such terms it is advisable to explain them.</p> <p>Since figures seem to be in appendix, proper labelling as app.1 and so on should be followed.</p>
