Faced with the fracture, it is reduced and as a CONSEQUENCE the replacement of the vascular-nerve package of the incisive canal.</p> <p>Throughout the article, the writing should improve with the use of the term "wiring"</p> <p>It must clarify in the article that the parents or guardians authorized the surgery with informed consent and that the Declaration of Helsinki was respected throughout the process.</p> <p>It is not clear if they did an intermaxillary block even with IMF, for the relocation of the occlusion (regardless of whether they are temporary)</p> <p>Why was a computed tomography not requested? They only rely on the panoramic view to perform the surgery. This is due to the high shortcomings that the initial panorama has.</p> <p>1. Patient with rings. 2. POSSIBLE lines can be visualized (they are not clearly visualized, for this reason the CT) of fracture in the right ascending branch and germ of 46 towards basal Regardless of the postoperative X-ray shows that everything resolved without any type of complication, there is a lack of clinical description or imaging studies In the return of the manuscript, insert the radiographic image with arrows so that the author explains what those lines are that are observed</p> <p>You should update the bibliography.
