<p>1. You need to choose the type of this document.</p> <p>2. I recommend slightly increasing the volume of the abstract and the number of keywords.</p> <p>3. I also recommend highlighting all the main sections (In particular, such sections can be: "Introduction", "Results", "Discussion" and "Conclusions"). Perhaps the "Results" section should start with the following sentence: "The following are the agroforestry systems which can be...".</p> <p>4. At the end of the introduction, you should indicate the purpose of the research.</p> <p>5. I cannot find a reference to Table 2 in the text of the manuscript.</p> <p>6. The text of the manuscript does not fully meet the requirements for its design. Authors should check the correctness of the design of their manuscript, starting with the abstract and ending with a list of sources. Particular attention should be paid to the correct design of the names of sections and subsections. Perhaps the authors should review articles that have already been published in this journal.
