Important findings directly related to the objectives of the study should be highlighted statistically</p> <p>The subsections and the structure are appropriate</p> <p>The scientific procedure was followed in writing the manuscript however the purpose sampling adopted could not be very appropriate at the participants selection level</p> <p>The references mostly are older than five years and only two are within five years (2020 and 2023). The author could have included many recent studies out there in the scientific space</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> In the statistical analysis section, the author stated that the following inferential statistics would be used but failed to do so: Pearson Product Moment Co-efficient was used to test the association between the variables, while multiple regression analysis was used to test the joint and relative effect of the variables. All results were tested at a 0.05 level of confidence. If the author cannot do as stated, he/she should delete that section Tables 3.3 and 5; the structure were Likert Scale type but the author applied simple percentages, no mean calculations for each variables was done and no average score in order to compare each variable mean with the average mean score and to make judgement. However, simple percentages could suffice but that do not align very well with the table structure and implied scoring system Discussion was not very robust but mere citations of previous studies
