In order to bring the manuscript up to date, the authors might compare the situation in 2020-2021 to the 2023 one, adding some sentences on the lessons that could be learned from the previous experiences.</p> <p>I really do not understand why the authors chose the proposed title. Nowhere the manuscript focuses on university students. Moreover, it can be supposed that university students do not need parental help. Maybe the authors will consider a different title, e.g. "Parental influence on K-12 pupils in the COVID-19 era" Quite sufficiently appropriate.</p> <p>It is likely that it is correct, but too vague and superficial.</p> <p>The references are quite recent, but I am sure the authors could improve this part: there are many articles and books that could be cited in the references. I write here just one of them: Rossella Marisi, Distance Education Prompted by Covid-19 Lockdowns: A Challenge for Teaching Musical Performing Arts, <i>Review of Artistic Education</i> 1(23):9-16</p>
