

**Editor's Comment:**

The manuscript submitted from to the Journal entitled Bacteriological Quality Assessment of Some Nigerian Indigenous Beverages Consumed in Calabar, Southern Nigeria reviewed by 3 reviewers. Particularly Prof. Sharma from India underlined some of the important points to improve the quality of the manuscript which include:

1. More samples should have been collected for study.
2. Introduction, objectives can be made comprehensive and outcome based
3. Conclusions drawn should be more specific
4. Quality of figures can be improved

Recent references should have been included.

I totally agree with the opinions of the reviewer. Obviously, the recommendations of Prof. Sharma was not taken into consideration. More importantly, the method used for the identification of the bacteria species isolated from limited number of the samples tested in the study is not appropriate to produce reliable results.
