It also aims to compare the quality of the most consumed green tea by Libyans that is available in the local market with the Libyan standard specification for tea. The study also intends to find out the best brewing time at which caffeine is in the highest concentration and tannin is in the lowest concentration. The manuscript would be complete if it included the applications of this study. However, it is unclear how the author determined that these five types are the most consumed. It would be helpful to include a reference or source that supports this statement.</li> <li>Figure 3; Geographical distribution should be presented in English.</li> <li>Figure 9 shows a preference for the duration of boiling green tea but the result of boiling for 1 hr is missing.</li> <li>Please correct KoH in Table 11.</li> <li>Please consider displaying Tables 12 and 13 as figures (e.g. graphs).</li> <li>How to determine that samples to be free of impurities and infected parts.</li> <li>"Static" significance was mentioned for several times. Please correct to "statistic".</li> <li>A statistical analysis should be performed to compare caffeine concentrations as well as to compare the tannin concentrations at various brewing durations.</li> <li>Please re-check the reference to ensure that it complies with the reference format.</li> </ol>
