For example; Characteristics and future possibilities of millet, a traditional crop</b></li> <li>3. <b>It is necessary to rewrite it based on the corrections to the main text.</b></li> <li>4. <b>It is necessary to describe it structurally. Chapters, sections, and sections should be set.</b></li> <li>5. <b>Some supplementary scientific explanation is required.</b></li> <li>6. <b>The references are sufficient and recent. <p><b>Optional/General</b> comments</p>	<p>This manuscript is of great significance in that it shows the benefits of millet from multiple angles with focusing on a literature review. Therefore, the construction of the thesis must be made clearer. First of all, please organize your chapters logically and precisely. Next, the summary of each chapter must give meaning to the "Prospects". At present, there are some cases in which we cannot find the basis for "Prospects " in the text. In addition, points with weak explanations are individually listed below.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. As indicated in the text, millet is a minor crop. This is because humans have needed crops that can provide more calories than beneficial nutrients. With this meaning in mind, it is necessary to objectively discuss the spread and promotion of millet. In other words, it is necessary to argue whether we aim for mixed cultivation and consumption of millet, rice and wheat, whether millet play a complementary role to rice and wheat, or whether we completely replace rice and wheat with millet.</li> <li>2. Another reason why millet became a minor crop was that it was difficult to become a target of commerce and trade. If it can be produced and distributed locally, it is unlikely that it will become a crop that constitutes a large-scale economy. Rather, shouldn't we aim for production and distribution in small regions? In particular, why not reorganize part "The Government's Role in Millets Promotion", keeping in mind that it is a small regional movement?</li> <li>3. In part "Patterns of millet production and consumption", there is the expression "As seen in Figure 1", but I can't find it.</li> </ol>
