The study should provide an in-depth research and valuable insights into the causes and consequences of absenteeism.</p> <p>The title effectively conveys the focus of the study. However, for added clarity, consider specifying the geographical location in the title, such as "Absenteeism for Medical Reasons in a Handling and Transport Company in Conakry."</p> <p>The abstract is comprehensive, covering the context, objectives, methods, and key results of the study. Although revisions are required.</p> <p>The structure is not appropriate. Considerate breaking down some lengthy sentences especially in the results and discussion sections for improved readability.</p> <p>The manuscript appears scientifically sound, supported by data and statistical analysis. However, it would be beneficial to provide more context on the factors contributing to the observed increase in absenteeism during the second year.</p> <p>The references are adequate, covering relevant literature. However, consider including more recent references if available, especially in the introduction where global statistics are mentioned.</p>

Consider a thorough proofreading to address these language issues.</p>
