I think that there is still a bit to do for the manuscript to be scientifically correct.</p> <p>6. Yes, the references sufficient and recent, but my suggestion is that when we use the numbering of the references in the document instead of citing the name of the author, here we have to start with the number 1, 2, 3... not, as you have done, this manuscript has started in alphabetical order, normally In the final part of the references, put the order by 1, 2, 3, respecting that you have done it in the text of the manuscript.</p>
