1. -the article needs correction of the English language	Made the required corrections
2. -the Abstract should refer to the presented case, and not to generalities on the topic	Made the required corrections
3. -the author should specify the clinic where the described intervention took place, and the time as well	Made the required corrections
4. -some specifications are required regarding the equipment used (manufacturer, country of origin) and the technical setting of the device for the mentioned treatment	BIOLASE is the name of the company
5. -a very interesting aspect for the readers concerns the anesthesia: was it performed for the case? Does the use of the Laser device make the anesthesia unnecessary? The authors should mention this	The use of anaesthesia is reduced in cases of treatment modalities done with laser. In this case, the use of local anaesthesia was required because the pain threshold of the patient was less.
6. -the titles of the figures must explain more clearly what they represent. The figures should be cited in text	Made the required corrections
7. -in the Discussion section the author should also discuss about similar cases in the literature	Made the required corrections
8. -the Conclusion section should refer strictly to the presented case, and not to generalities in the literature	Made the required corrections
9. -many of the References are not cited in text. The author should cite all the 10 References mentioned at the end of the manuscript	Made the required corrections
