It is very important, the issues raised are quite familiar in several countries, it is quite sad that the "trust" of health workers in hospitals who are friendly and understand the patient's condition is not evenly distributed, and the results of this study also show that there is a phenomenon where the prevalence of giving birth at home is reported as many as (36 .5%) among the respondents. More than a quarter (35.5%) of respondents rated the satisfaction of giving birth at their home as good, while more than half of the respondents rated the attitude of the traditional birth attendant as good. Three (3) qualitative respondents indicated that most women chose to give birth at home ignoring the hospital because of the better satisfaction obtained from giving birth at home 2.
