They are appropriate The manuscript seems to be scientifically correct, but most include details of the Full genome sequencing done to the patient, do not mention what were the treatment given by the dermatologist apart from IVIg. The text talk about diarrheal disease, but no mention if any microbiological study was done which is important to know if any pathogen were involved given the nature of the diagnosis of THI. An account of other studies if done should be given. References are appropriate, some are not recent but it can be understood that it is not an often condition. Some new references to support the diagnosis of THI and AD can be added anyway | |
