In general, research involving actions and discussions to prevent climate change is always well necessary and accepted among the scientific community. However, a scientific-technical paper for journal publication must be based on studies references, methods, results and discussions.</p> <p>2. The manuscript title is suitable.</p> <p>3. The Abstract is too short and has to be complemented with a brief subject introduction, primary objective, brief methodology description and main findings. This section is like a "showcase" and essential to promote the reader's interest in your work. Thus, the main summarized information about the research must be present.</p> <p>4. I suggest a manuscript restructuring. The topics must contain an Introduction followed by the main objective. Then, an in-depth and current literature review to support the methodology. Then, the study methodology, results, discussion and conclusions.</p> <p>5. I found some issues that could be improved in this manuscript. First, there are many self-citations, mainly in the introduction. The political bias of the introduction should be incorporated into the discussions supported by references. There need to be more references (few references were attached). The figures need to have better quality. Figure 1 is strange and unreferenced, and it needs to be adequate. Units must be SI (some not was). Wikipedia is not allowed as a reference in journals. It was impossible to understand the objective, the adopted method and the contributions of the manuscript. It still needs clarification. The language of a paper cannot be personal. Examples: "This is my .."; "So I ...", and "I was sent ...", among many others in the text.</p> <p>7. The attached references are insufficient, as previously mentioned.</p>
