It is suggested to order the presentation of the case according to the CARE guidelines for presentation of clinical cases.</p> <p>5. Yes, this manuscript is scientifically correct, but the authors must clarify whether there was parental consent for the publication of the background of this case and also add the approval of the Ethics Committee to be able to publish it.</p> <p>6. References are appropriate and up to date</p> <p>Additional Suggestions:</p> <p>1. In the introduction present a summary of the background and relevance with reference to the pertinent medical literature. Authors are requested to post information about the prevalence of tuberculous osteomyelitis in children according to data provided by government organizations or literature reports.</p> <p>2. Present a calendar of events to better communicate the sequence of events surrounding the case with the dates of diagnoses and interventions.</p> <p>3. In the discussion, mention the strengths and limitations in the management of this case and compare it with the existing literature.</p> <p>4. Also, it would be interesting to place the perspective of the patient and her parents: it is relevant that the patient or her parents or guardians can relate her experience throughout the process, so the authors should include it in the case report.</p>
