Comentarios adicionales Delete tables 1 Staphylococcus aureus infection multidrug-resistant, incidence and 2 incidence by gender, because they are not required. Mention the total results in the text in both cases. Eliminate figures 1, 2 and 3. It is enough to show the results with the tables In table 3, place the results of the positive samples, not the negative ones. In Discussion only comment on relevant results.
