The manuscript deals with an important and current issue and it is important for the scientific community.</p> <p>2. The title of the article is not suitable. The words "<i>before pandemic</i>" do not appear in the text. At the date of the research 31st March 2018 there is no pandemic. So we recommend the new title " CAPITAL STRUCTURE DECISIONS OF LISTED FIRMS IN TRANSPORT EQUIPMENT INDUSTRY IN INDIA ".</p> <p>3. The abstract of the article is suitable and well structured. I have no other title suggestions to make.</p> <p>4. I consider subsections and structure of the manuscript appropriate.</p> <p>5. The manuscript is scientifically correct.</p> <p>6.1. The references are not written correctly, for example the reference "Gujarati, D. N. (2009). Basic econometrics. Tata McGraw-Hill Education" is incorrect. The correct reference is "Gujarati, D. N., Porter D.C. (2009), Basic econometrics. McGraw-Hill Education". All the bibliography must be rewritten correctly.</p> <p>6.2. The references contain only 1 bibliographic source from 2020-2022 years. That's all that was written on the subject in this period of time?! We recommend rewriting the literature chapter with more new bibliographical sources.</p> <p>It is not specified how the sample was selected (pages 5). Why were 83 companies chosen? Why not 82 or 81? Why did the selection process end on 31st March 2018? Why not on 29th March 2018 or 21st March 2018? Why was selected the period 2008-2018?! If is about pandemic why not (2010-2020) period?</p> <p>The statistical rigor is lacking in the sampling part. These aspects must be explained in detail.</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>1. English language is adequate.</p>	
<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>All in all, it is an interesting work, which has potential but still needs a lot of work to fulfil scientific rigor.</p>
