The researcher only explain descriptive research design leaving the other two. I kindly suggest that comparative and correlational research designs should be explained or simply defined. 2. The research instrument used for data collection was a "modified research questionnaire". It will be appropriate if the researcher provide a simply explanation of the process of validity of the instrument as well as reliability tasking into consideration the type of statistics used to obtained the reliability index (r value). 3. Subsection 3.0 reads "Results and Discussion". The researcher however did the discussion before the results were presented in the table. I therefore suggest that subsection 3.0 should be captioned "Results" then subsection 4.0 should be captioned "Discussion of Findings" accordingly. 4. If comment 3 above is followed, the researcher is therefore expect to adequately discuss the findings utilizing relevant literatures. This implies that the references will not be adequate. 5. The following references were not captured in the body of the work; (i) Glenn, P. J. (1965). (ii) Hernandez, R. (1995). (iii) Lally, P., van Jaarsveld, C. H. M., Potts, H. W. W., & Wardle, J. (2009). 6. One citation (Magielse, 2020) paragraph 2, line 8 was captured in the body of the work but not in the references. 7. The recommendation should properly itemized, i.e (i), (ii), (iii) and so on.
