It is approved for publication, but with specific circumstances based on the suggestions that were made by the reviewers and the commitment of the authors to the recommendations that were made by the reviewers. It is my sincere wish that the authors consider these points in accordance with the journal's guidelines for the publication of research articles.

Article about the study that may be considered reasonable the authors didn't care that the abstract wasn't written according to the journal's instructions, and they also didn't check their own work. In addition, the abbreviations were written initially, such as in the abstract and the introduction, and then the complete versions were produced afterwards, within the framework of the study. The abbreviations "RDF& FYM and DAI" that were mentioned in the study were included before the reference; however, the authors failed to add the abbreviations that were specified in the paper before the reference. Tables: Table A was the first table that the writers worked on, followed by Tables 1 and 2. Following the norm, the right numbers need to be assigned to the table. The references used are quite old; to strengthen the scientific study and demonstrate its validity, you will need to include references from more recent studies. And the authors are requested to add paragraphs that were not mentioned in the research paper, following the policy of the journal, and one of the most important responsibilities that I have is to maximize the influence of publication while keeping the high quality of the papers it publishes.

Research Papers and Short Notes should follow the structure of Abstract, Introduction, Methodology, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgements, Competing Interests, Authors' Contributions, Consent (where applicable), Ethical approval (where applicable), and References plus figures and/or tables.
