<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Please give an explanation about kharif and rabi in Abstract and Methodology part.</li> <li>2. What is Dr YSRHU KVK stands for ? Please give a complete name</li> <li>3. For results and discussions part, please give a percent (%) mark on Table 1, 2 and 4. For example : Rainfall (%), Temperature (%), Weather related (%), field operation (%), etc.</li> <li>4. For every "per cent" word in every section, it is better to change it into % than per cent word.</li> <li>5. For Results and discussions part, it is better to explain the findings of Manjusree R. V. et al (These finding were also supported by the work of Manjusree R. V. et al., (2022))</li> <li>6. For table 3, what is Coc/ha and B:C ratio stands for ?</li> </ol>
