The unit of the parameters in the abscissa and the ordinates are not provided in Figure 7, Figure 8, Figure 9, Figure 10, Figure 12. E.g. what is the unit of distance and what's the unit of costing and earning. These should be displayed on the figures too.2. Few grammar errors, some are highlighted in yellow in the manuscript.3. Under Section 7, though the sub-heading says Conclusion and policy implication. No policy implications can be found in this section.4. I will advise that policy implication be removed from the sub-heading title or the section be modified with policy recommendations related to the work
