As for its opportunity, the existence of patriarchal societies, the objectification of women in the media, and the need to fight against the passivity of women, demonstrate the opportunity of the study, even if the film is not recent (7 years old). As for relevance, evidence of the advantages of the structural and power balance between men and women, the attribution of human rights to men and women without distinction, and the imperative of early childhood education that promotes gender equality as the basis of unity in families modern, underlie this study. As for methodological correctness, the communication document format and type of article is adequate, the structure, description and logic of the development of the work are very good, the summary explains the objectives in a complete way, the methodology and conclusions, the keywords key are sufficient (although the word equality could be added), the introduction is extensive with a background that should be shortened, the objectives and justification of the study are well presented, the research questions are the most timely, the literature review and references theory are well suited, the sampling and research methods are justified, the representation is restricted, the data analysis (film) is very well described in its aspects and with good interpretation, the discussion is appropriate and is well discriminated, the conclusion is adequate although without timely recommendations not assuming gender equality, in the bibliographic references there is a description of references in the text not included at the end, thanks where some are not recent, and there are authors cited by others many times, the work being well systematized, without serious epidemiological violations and with many reasoned considerations. As for the content, it is a work adjusted to the approach of the patriarchal society and the submission of women, with a description of perspectives of economic independence, personal fulfillment and the right to pleasure of women. In global analysis, the work "Under Construction: The Female Gaze in Women Director's Film" is a good work, as an original research article, with an interest in the geographic region, in the social environment, and the need for intervention in formal and informal education in men and women and promotion of gender equality.</p>
