The abstract is comprehensive and gives an insight of the whole article.</p> <p>4. The sub-sections and structure of the article are appropriate.</p> <p>5. The manuscript is scientifically correct.</p> <p>6. The references are insufficient and not recent. The author(s) are required to add more relevant and recent references in the Introduction part of the article and make introduction part a bit lengthy for readers to get a better idea of the background of the study.</p> <p>Additional comments:</p> <p>i. The keywords are traditionally written in alphabetical order separated by semicolons. The author(s) may please take a note of it.</p> <p>ii. The authors should include some photographs of the actual sites, soil samples, curds, etc. for better understanding of the research.</p> <p>iii. The Longitude and Latitude of the study areas should also be mentioned for better clarity to readers not well versed with the location by name.</p> <p>iv. The author(s) should provide some information about the prevailing weather conditions, temperatures, rainfall data, humidity, etc. and their effects on the soil quality that would help the readers to gauge the research better.</p> <p>v. The author(s) should add a "future scope of study" section after the conclusion section, describing in brief how this current research can help in future research.</p>
