On the contrary, terms like homeopathic preparation or homeopathy, with regard to the concept of dilution and succussion, cannot be measured in any term, be it traditional or innovative. To date, a controlled trial comparing standard medication to homeopathic medication is comparing medication to something which can be assumed as placebo, or an inactive vehicle including environmental, cultural and other unknown factors, not corresponding to homeopathic concepts, which remain undefined. With regard to the history of homeopathy, part of the conceptual frame has become part of traditional medicine, as in allergology and immunology. As for the current practice called homeopathy, before any evidence can be discussed, we should remark that no definition has been provided, such as to enable to distinguish any preparation from eccipients or simple pure vehicles used for dilution.</p>
