The objective of the investigations as well as hypotheses (Research Questions) should have been mentioned along with its findings. More weightage was given for methodology. Just five key words were stated, out of which Kurtosis, and Tiuchirappalli District are common, instead 'resilience in soil' and 'adapter cultivars' could be added.</p> <p>4. Introduction and methodology are presented elaborately. A little review of past literature should have been added.</p> <p>5. The principal findings should have been documented in conclusion part.</p> <p>6. The references cited are completely obsolete. APA style is widely used in research. They are cited alphabetically and follow the specific format and rules of the citation style you are using. References till 2023 were cited.</p> | |
