It is one of the most common causes of emergency admission with abdominal pain often requiring surgical intervention. Intestinal strangulation caused by appendix is extremely rare with very few cases reported. Pre-operatively it is very difficult to diagnose this condition. The diagnosis is always made at the time of laparotomy. The treatment varies from appendectomy to intestinal resection or even right hemicolectomy.
