Key words- may be limited to 4-8, no abbreviations and author may refer to the MeSH terminology for key words</p> <p>Introduction- Author may kindly refer to the recent data and make this part more specific. Like in reference no. 3 – how much reduction. It should describe the rationale of the study, not only the burden.</p> <p>Aim and objectives to be written separately.</p> <p>Methodology – may be written under the specific sub headings (pls refer the journal guidelines). Some highlighted text need clarification. Check for grammatical errors</p> <p>Results- In methodology the no. of participants are 5871 and in results they are mentioned 5869, author may kindly clarify. Description of the tables may be made clearer and more specific (some portion highlighted) Author can combine some categories of variables to make the results more interpretable.</p> <p>Discussion- Results may not be repeated much and more evidences from recent studies may be added.</p> <p>Conclusion- should be more specific and convey what author wants to say.</p> <p>Ethical approval, Conflict of interest and acknowledgement may be given under a separate heading.</p> <p>5. Yes</p> <p>6. References- may be cited according to journal guidelines or Vancouver style of referencing. More references from recent study may be added.</p>
