Authors have quoted Hinke et al, Cheng et al in the text but did not include them in the reference list. Please include them in the reference list.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In abstract- observations- authors have used the abbreviation CCI; this may be corrected as ICC</li> <li>• Authors have mentioned that in Jan.2023 before removing the catheter chest X-ray was taken which revealed the distal migrated catheter ‘wrapped around the pulmonary artery’ and then in March 2023, TTE was done. What was the condition of the patient in interim? Did he have any symptoms? Please clarify.</li> </ul> <p>In discussion authors have mentioned “Since its invention in 1657 by Sir Christopher Wren, the implantable catheter chamber has revolutionized the management and quality of life of cancer patients [1]. “ Please rephrase the sentence because it is giving the impression that ICC was discovered in 1657!!! Sir Wren used hollow quill of a bird to inject drugs into veins of dogs.”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ‘A rare complication is pulmonary rupture and’ ; please delete “pulmonary”. Why use the word pulmonary?</li> <li>• The clinic is generally poor as in our patient who is asymptomatic. Please rephrase the sentence.</li> <li>• In conclusion “Rupture and embolization of the right pulmonary artery is a rare complication of the implantable catheter chamber” Please rephrase the sentence as it is giving a wrong meaning.</li> </ul>
