The study attempts to investigate the impact of sales growth, performance and firm size on firm value. The author(s) reinvestigate the relationships by using infrastructure companies in Indonesia. Although similar investigations are quite common, this study may make unique contributions by focusing a certain industry sector in Indonesian context.</p> <p>2. It would be better rephrase the title as "The effect of Sales Growth, Financial Performance, and Firm Size on Firm Value: Using Indonesian Infrastructure Companies" to better reflect its contributions to infrastructure companies in Indonesia.</p> <p>3. Abstract is not comprehensive or not well written. It misses some parts such as implications of the study.</p> <p>4. Overall, the paper is not well structured and consistent. From introduction itself, author(s) talks about operating capacity. But the title tells nothing about it. Literature review is not comprehensive and consistent. Author(s) discusses about the signalling theory, but no explanation is given how it relates to this study. Nothing was mentioned about the similar studies that investigated the relationship among the study variables. Hypotheses were poorly formulated. Methodology is not comprehensive enough. No variable definitions or data analysis techniques were given. Conclusion, implication and limitations are not either comprehensive or correct</p> <p>5. No. results and findings are not consistent.</p> <p>6. References are sufficient. But in text citation and references list is not consistent. For an example, there are some in text citations that are not in the reference list. Referencing is not consistent with APA style.</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	No. lots of typos (ex: author(s) discusses about a Table 03, but there is no such table). Direct mentioning the names of some companies is also not appropriate. Very poorly written paper. Some sentences are not complete and some are grammatically incorrect.
