The author did injustice to the review paper because they failed to do a broad spectrum of literature review.</p> <p>Several factors to consider in improving manuscript.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. More emphasis should be put on the main points that are on the title like the nutritional composition and health benefits. 2. More literature has to be used for comparative analysis because different researcher will find different results on either the health or nutritional components of Ragi; the differences could emanate from different things i.e. seed colour; if the author had done extensive literature review this could have been observed and added to the manuscript to improve its quality 3. Observing differences as per researchers' results will help the author also identify factors that lead to these differences, and this could be an important factor in the manuscript as it will help farmers either in the agronomic management or post-harvest handling of the Ragi to maintain its quality. <p>The manuscript could be beneficial to the improved cultivation and adoption of finger millet, because the crop is slowly becoming one of the forgotten crops (orphans) even though it has high potential to mitigate and contribute to the food security of the world because of its nutritional quality and health benefits it possesses.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. the title is comprehensives enough 3. the abstract can be improved also through extensive literature review. 4. are detailed literature review will help include more important subsections, but for now the structure is good enough. 5.yes 6. a detailed literature review will improve the references.
