Brain MRI revealed multiple acute bilateral frontal, parietal-occipital lobes, and basal ganglia infarcts. This case report is potentially interesting, but the manuscript can be improved according to the following suggestions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Please change in the text "Babinski positive" to "presence of Babinski's sign" 2. Delete "etc" at the end of the Introduction and "?" (in "Investigations" section). 3. It would be useful to mention that the differential diagnosis is also in hematological disorders which are a commonly unrecognized cause of ischemic stroke (Expert Rev Hematol 2016; 9: 891-901). This study should be added and commented on. 4. It is highly recommended that the authors homogenize the format of the Figures according to the author guidelines of the Journal.
