<p><b>Minor REVISION</b> comments</p> <p>1. <b>Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</b></p>	<p>1- The language is suitable for scholarly communications</p> <p>Interesting case where it deals with a specific anesthetic procedure in a patient with arrhythmogenic right ventricular dysplasia. Patients with this clinical condition have an increase in arrhythmic events associated with stimulation of adrenergic receptors. The case describes a possible better benefit of surgical procedures when anesthesia was performed with remimazolam. I would like to discuss some details to contribute to the paper:</p> <p>1- A good review was carried out on heart disease and its peculiarities of ventricular arrhythmias. I believe that despite the pathology being relatively uncommon, it is important to know its evolution.</p> <p>2-I would like to suggest the same precautions in the review of remimazolam: detailed pharmacology, duration of action, half-life, main indications.</p> <p>3-associate the indication of remimazolam and discuss the possible advantages in patients with right ventricular heart disease (lesser beta-adrenergic effect?/ better in association with other anesthetics?)</p> <p>4- would there be advantages in the association of beta blockers to reduce the incidence of arrhythmias?</p> <p>5-despite the low incidence of right ventricular heart disease, which possible future study would the authors propose to adequately answer the questions</p>
