<p><b>Minor REVISION</b> comments</p> <p>1. <b>Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</b></p>	<p>There are spelling mistakes in the text. For eg., Herfindahl index, table is spelled incorrectly. The script needs proofreading and grammar checking. Also check the usage of HHI and IHH in the text. The English grammar needs to be checked thoroughly-at various places there are grammatical mistakes.</p>	
<p><b>Optional/General</b> comments</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Full forms of the acronyms should be provided at the first instance of usage (for eg., BRI, BNI, BAC). Later only the acronyms can be used. Please check the manuscript for this.</li> <li>• The introduction section contains a paragraph on the Indonesian Banking industry related to 2018. This paragraph should come second last in the section-just before the last paragraph in the introduction section.</li> <li>• While deriving the hypothesis H1a , H1b is written but while testing the hypothesis H1A and H1B is written. Please maintain uniformity.</li> <li>• The conclusion is written hypothesis-wise-which is well written.</li> <li>• The last lines of the first paragraph of the conclusion can be reframed –just to show which aspects are not accepted. The first and second paragraphs of the conclusion need to be written clearly. The last paragraph is unclear and does not indicate what the governments should do. The intention of the paragraph is not appropriately worded.</li> </ul>
