It would be a scope for further studies to the research fraternity.</p> <p>The Title needs to be modified as per the work carried out. "Antibacterial activity of Star fruit extract against <i>Vibrio cholera</i> isolated from Tuna fish"</p> <p>The abstract is comprehensive but certain points needs to be checked- Use of appropriate terms (e.g using antibacterial property instead of power; Tukey's honestly significant difference instead of honest significant difference etc), Using full forms for the abbreviation (e.g. BSIL), and use of appropriate scientific terms (e.g. use sub-culturing instead of refresh 24 hrs incubation instead of storage etc).</p> <p>The structure of the manuscript does not follow the guidelines as per the Journal. The subsections are not numbered. The article appears to be written from a thesis that mentions tools and research design in the methodology. Titles of subsections need to be corrected.</p> <p>There are lacunae in the article – Photographs of antimicrobial activity of all the extracts (Both variables – Percentage of ethanol & temperature) to be incorporated, Graphical presentations of statistical data to be incorporated. Protocol mentions – Maceration, which is not exactly done in the given study, SI units should be correctly mentioned, Figure and Table captions should be self-explanatory and correct, Data on statistical analysis to be incorporated completely and correctly</p> <p>The references cited in the article should be numbered. The references are not mentioned as per the guidelines.</p> <p>The conclusion should be paragraphed.</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications? 	<p>The research article needs to be more refined and polished. There are grammatical errors in sentence framing, unstructured & repetitive sentences, spelling mistakes, formatting errors that needs to be looked upon.</p>
