Adding vitamin C to it can increase its nutritional properties, and thanks to its low fat content and lower amount of calories, it can be used in the diet of cardiological patients in the future.</p> <p>Yes</p> <p>Generally yes but the last sentence included in the "Abstract" part about the research methodology should be included before giving information about the research results obtained. Was the prepared sauce evaluated by 10 or 40 panellists?</p> <p>Individual sections of the manuscript require additional information. Is the following sentence given in the "Introduction" section - "Amla is a vitamin C enriched anti-oxidant fruit offers a promising approach for the promotion of health by means of reducing immunity of human body." factually correct? Was the purpose of the study only to prepare the sauce? Please provide additional information. In Table 1, the authors list the ingredients used in various combinations. It is not entirely clear what was prepared based on the list of ingredients presented. Please clarify. In addition, the authors used spices when preparing the sauce. Please list them in the section on its preparation.</p> <p>Enriching the manuscript with the elements included in the note above will improve its scientific value.</p> <p>Latin plant names should be written in italics. The names of journals should also be written according to the requirements for authors. Literature items need to be matched to requirements.</p>
