The last paragraph puts in a few words only the justification of the study. 2 - Tables: All figures in the text must be referenced, including tables, even if they are authored by the author. 3 - In conclusion, write a paragraph with suggestions for future work. 4 - In the references, cite articles already published in the International Journal of Environment and Climate Change related in some way to the subject of your work.
