

### **Editor's Comment:**

Accepted after the minor revisions listed under

- the article needs text correction and minor English correction
  - the references number should be placed in square brackets in text (not authors' names), before the full stop. References should be numbered in the order of their appearance in text. Please pay attention to cite in text all the References found in the "References" section.
  - all the abbreviations should be explained the first time they appear in text
  - the ethical aspects should be addressed: informed consent obtained from the patient, ethical approval provided by the institutional committee etc.
  - the titles of the figures must explain more clearly what they represent. The figures should be numbered and presented in the order of their citation in text, and in chronological order (the order of events succession)
  - in the Discussion section, first paragraph: what is the exponential "6" on "documented"?
  - the Conclusions should be more focused on the presented case
  - the References are old. Please consider more recent references, as many recent studies are found on the internet on the topic. Also, the References style should follow the recommendations of the Journal. Very important!
