Add reference to Analysis of ALT Enzyme 7- Write the number of ethical approval 8- What is the age of your participants? 9- Did you exclude any participants? 10- The objective of your study is to find relationship between obesity and elevated Alanine Aminotransferase level, but in statistical analysis there is no test for assessing this relationship. 11- How did you measure the homogeneity of the sample? 12- Add a new table for demographic data in results section. 13- Write Results in a separate title. 14- References are sufficient but it needs to be written in one style.
