References from other studies missing. Table 2 and 3 have blank columns, then why to include them, author can simply describe them in text, table 5 and figure 2 are repetitions. Author may kindly do the calculations again as number and percentages in tables doesn't match 'n' (some are highlighted)<br/> <b>Author may kindly mention the limitations of the study</b><br/> <b>References-</b> both in-text and in the end may be cited according to the Vancouver style of referencing or journal guidelines, author may kindly refer. Also more evidences from recent studies may be added.<br/> <b>Conclusion-</b> may be made more specific and should answer the aim and objectives of the study</p> |   |
