However, its conclusions and discussion can be improved to better reflect on how this impacts the different variables, mainly as they concluded how the sex variable affects the motivation of this type of learning. There is only a factual conclusion based on the statistical analysis. There is no international comparison or no reflection regarding the literature review made.</p> <p>The title is suitable. However, it has to be correct since it has the wrong spelling. The abstract has to be improved in the use of English.</p> <p>Yes</p> <p>There are 16 references in the bibliography that were not used in the literature review. Therefore, they shouldn't be in the paper's bibliography. More recent articles should be added.</p> | |
| <p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications? | <p>The use of English must be improved.</p> | |
| <p>Optional/General comments</p> | <p>Overall the article is like some of the already existing ones but regarding different countries. It is an interesting theme but has to be improved, particularly since there are more studies like this one in different countries an international comparison would enrich the research. The empirical work seems well done, but since there is not enough reflection and discussion between the data found and the literature review has a poor impact.</p> <p>Improvements to be made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • English use improvement. • Spelling correction of title and abstract. • Literature review – correct the plagiarism identified; introduce more recent research; introduce some of the 16 references in the bibliography if necessary. • Discussion and conclusion – introduced international comparison; improve the possible causes of the results found. • Bibliography – delete the references not used. | |
