The title of the article is in accordance with the issue studied. The summary of the article is comprehensive, being composed of 230 words. The structure of the article is classic and appropriate. It can be appreciated that the manuscript is scientifically correct. The article is well built and it has a clarity of informations. There is a logic thread of the presentation and argumentation which makes the article relatively easy crossing. The used language can be easily read and understood. The style and expression of the authors are clear and coherent, no expression mistakes. However, there is an exaggerated repetition (23 times) of the word "therefore". The article contains 19 bibliographical sources. The three most recent sources are published in 2022, 2019, and 2014, respectively; the others appeared more than 14 years ago. An update of the bibliography would be required.</p>	
<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>Is the right alignment of the article title a technical editing requirement in the journal? Spaces are required before and after the titles of sections and subsections of the article. The font for writing the title "1. INTRODUCTION" must be Arial 12, not Arial 11. In subsection 2.2, the numbers of the cited bibliographic sources must not be written in bold. The title of subsection "3.1 PSC MODEL AND RELOCATION NEXUS" is not written entirely in capital letters. Authors are indicated in References section by name, followed by a comma, and then by the initials of the first name. The titles of the articles in References section are not written between the symbols ", but after the comma (not after :), in italic font. The journals in which they are printed are written in normal font, not italics.</p>
