

Editor's Comment:

The authors made the following conclusions: "...Based on the results obtained, most of the participants did not fit to the correct ergonomic sitting posture of the MPVs seat as the overall RULA assessment indicated yellow in color, suggesting further investigation require. This could be concluded to several clarifications. Firstly, the Malaysian male drivers may not fit into the MPVs driver's seats design. Secondly, data taken may not be accurate as simple measurement was performed. Thirdly, MPVs driver may not practice to the correct sitting position. Therefore, it is suggested further research be conducted such as gathering more data of Malaysian MPVs driver and using more advance techniques....". The author talks a lot about further research, they should show their research results in writing the article. A personal study result is too small or not significant. The authors need to improve the conclusions of the article.

When researching, it may be necessary to take into account the following indicators: overall dimensions and softness of the fabric of the driver's seat are different in different cars. The physique of people - drivers (height and width of a person) differs from the continents of Asia, Africa, Europe and America, for example, the physique of Wetnam drivers is small, and Nigeria's large figures.

It may also be necessary to take into account in this study the distance between the driver's hands and the steering wheel, between the foot and the brake pedal and the car's clutch.

After some corrections and additions, taking into account the above wishes, it will be possible to publish this article in the journal.

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
