My recommendations are minor changes as missing space intervals, different font of the letters in two places in the text, missing abbreviations etc. In the results: It will be more comprehensible to change the position of the p-value (in table 4) in table 2 and tabl.3, respectively. Thus both tables (2 and 3) will be more detailed and complete. The title and the abstract are suitable. The references of the manuscript are correctly written. However about 50% of Ref. that are quoted are published in the past ten years.
