Manuscript is important to dental practitioners and odontologists as diagnosing and treating oral candidiasis is important, especially in HIV infected individuals. 2. Title can be modified as "Oral Candidiasis in Human immunodeficiency Virus infection - A Brief Review". 3. The abstract is comprehensive. However, the first sentence can be rephrased as " Oral cavity shows various manifestations that results from HIV infection". 4. The subsections and structure of the manuscript are appropriate. 5. The manuscript mentions Black hairy tongue as one type of oral candidiasis. Literature says that black hairy tongue is actually caused by hypertrophy of filiform papillae and might be superimposed with candida, but cannot be considered as a primary form of oral candidiasis. Similarly, perleche and angular cheilitis refer to the same condition and need not be mentioned as two different entities. The article is very brief, the authors can elaborate more on mycological examination and include about special stains and various types of molecular methods for identification of candida. 6. The references are recent and sufficient.

There are grammatical errors in the manuscript and quality of the English language is not appropriate. The authors are requested to get technical help for the same to modify the manuscript.
