<p>Minor REVISION comments</p> <p>1. Is language/English quality of the article suitable for scholarly communications?</p>	<p>1. The language is adequate.</p>	
<p>Optional/General comments</p>	<p>1. The abstract of the article must be structured in order to contain the following subsections: Aims, Study design, Place and Duration of Study, Methodology, Results and Conclusions. Also, as per the "General Guidelines for Authors", the abstract should not exceed 300 words, but the abstract for this manuscript is 331 words, so it should be amended.</p> <p>2. The formatting of the article must be corrected, as according to "the guide for authors", the text of the manuscript must be written in Arial, normal, size 10, justified. As for the sections and subsections, there should also be correct formatting. For example, the "Introduction" section should be written in arial, bold, 11 fonts, left aligned, uppercase.</p> <p>3. As for the references, they should be reviewed according to the examples contained in the "guide for authors", since some manuscript references have dots after the authors' names, while others do not.</p> <p>4. It is suggested that the conclusions be written in the form of running text, and not in the format of items.</p>
