

Editor's Comment:

The paper is well-structured, well-written, and of value to the public's health and the healthcare community in the field.

In my editorial, I had three main notes to be taken care of by the authors before publishing:

1- Add a paragraph at the end of the transcript, just before the conclusion, to mention both study limitations and how the confounding variables were controlled for. In this paragraph, too, the authors are also encouraged to mention any study's strengths they would like.

2- In the results section, to move the results of descriptive statistics up to come first before the results of the analytical part.

3- In the discussion section, the first paragraph, it starts with information about myopia among Chinese children and then comparing them with those in Bangladesh school children. I recommended to also switch the sequence, that is to start with the findings in Bangladesh first then compare with those of China and all other countries.

These were all my notes, to be responded to by the authors and then I'd like to review them again before a decision to publish.
