1. The original title "A comparative analysis of" is good rather than the revised title
and in the abstract the authors can mention the metric with which the comparisons are carried out.
2. Some of the sentences in the abstract and conclusion are too lengthy and need grammatical correction.
3. The titles of the tables in the manuscript also need grammatical corrections.
4. Kindly check the entire paper for grammatical corrections using any free software as it will improve the
readability of the paper.
5. Consider the sentence in the Aim "The research purpose is to make comparisons and find the best search algorithm between binary search and interpolation search algorithms for searching identity number on Indonesian identity cards".

Though the MS word does not show any corrections but the phrase " The research purpose is to make comparisons"

does not seem to be fine

It can be rewritten for example

"The purpose of the work carried out in this research is to find the best"

It is only a suggestion to improve the quality.
