The introduction does not provide an adequate description of the problem addressed and does not show the importance of the research problem, is scientifically limited. The methodology used is appropriate to the purpose of the research, but scientifically limited; The results are interesting and important to researchers in relevant fields of medicine, but for the publication of this study, I recommend supplementing it with other studies to support its importance and opportunity;</p> <p>5. The purpose or goal of the work is within the journal's scope. I recommend relating the informations from this study to other similar studies, a very important aspect to support the results obtained;</p> <p>6. The number of references is limited and some corrections need to be made. I recommend the inclusion of a larger number of more recent studies on the subject and their insertion in bibliographic references;</p> <p>My recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I recommend a critical approach to the literature to enable analysis and interpretation of the information, development of an objective viewpoint and the setting of clear objectives; - The presentation of the informations from this study is very short, without reference to other studies with similar results and I recommend a review of this issue; - I recommend that conclusions be formulated highlighting the importance of the results obtained; <p>I do not recommend publishing the manuscript in this form.</p>
