The coordinate or the map of the region will do justice to that so as to make readers to be familiar with the terrain.</li> <li>2. Figure 1 was not referred to in the work</li> <li>3. Figure 2 was not referred to in the work</li> <li>4. The references were not properly arranged in Alphabetical order.</li> <li>5. The paper should generally be rearranged for alignment and spacing</li> </ol>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The positions of the titles of the two figures (Figure 1 and Figure 2) in the work is not consistent and does not align. It is either they are at the centre or left aligned.</li> <li>2. Some of the sentences are too long, they should be broken into two or three sentences e.g the first sentence under "Introduction"  <p>Balkan have been shaken by wars and migrations for centuries, and where migration and nomadic life are practically a century-old way of survival, fruit trees are synonymous with peaceful living and the first sign that someone has settled in one place, where he sees the stability in front of him long enough to be able to plant fruit trees that will grow, bloom and bear fruit for many years to come.</p> <p>Also, the fourth paragraph under INTRODUCTION  The richness of the pear gene pool, but also its importance and value, can be highlighted by the fact that in BiH today about 20,000 pear seedlings are grafted and sold, which spontaneously expanded and received the status of indigenous varieties, although to date this issue is not scientifically processed and it has not been scientifically confirmed how much is really such genetic material that can be determined as a variety, or it is a population of genotypes under a common name, that is the same genotypes that have been given different local names[1].</p> <p>This because you have lost the memory of the information before concluding the sentence.
