Unequivocally, good and demystified analysis, backed up with essential data and factual. Conspicuously, created rooms for further provocative researches and financial tests. However, the articles needs more grammar check beyond the few spotted below:</p> <p>Line 6: keyword, Make in India, should be "Made in India";</p> <p>Line 40: "This is made the world more horrified and pessimistic", need better construction, "This has made the world more horrified and pessimistic";</p> <p>Line 231: RBI must be defined where first mentioned in the text i.e. Reserved Bank of India, RBI;</p> <p>Line 454: "QR Code-enabled payment in select countries in Europe." Sound better, "QR Code-enabled payment in the selected countries in Europe.";</p> <p>Line 460: check "To list some o them are", needs correction "To list some of them are";</p> <p>Line 483: check "three months visa o Indian", needs correction "three months visa to Indian";</p> <p>Lines 498 and 500: "COP", acronym should be defined.</p>
